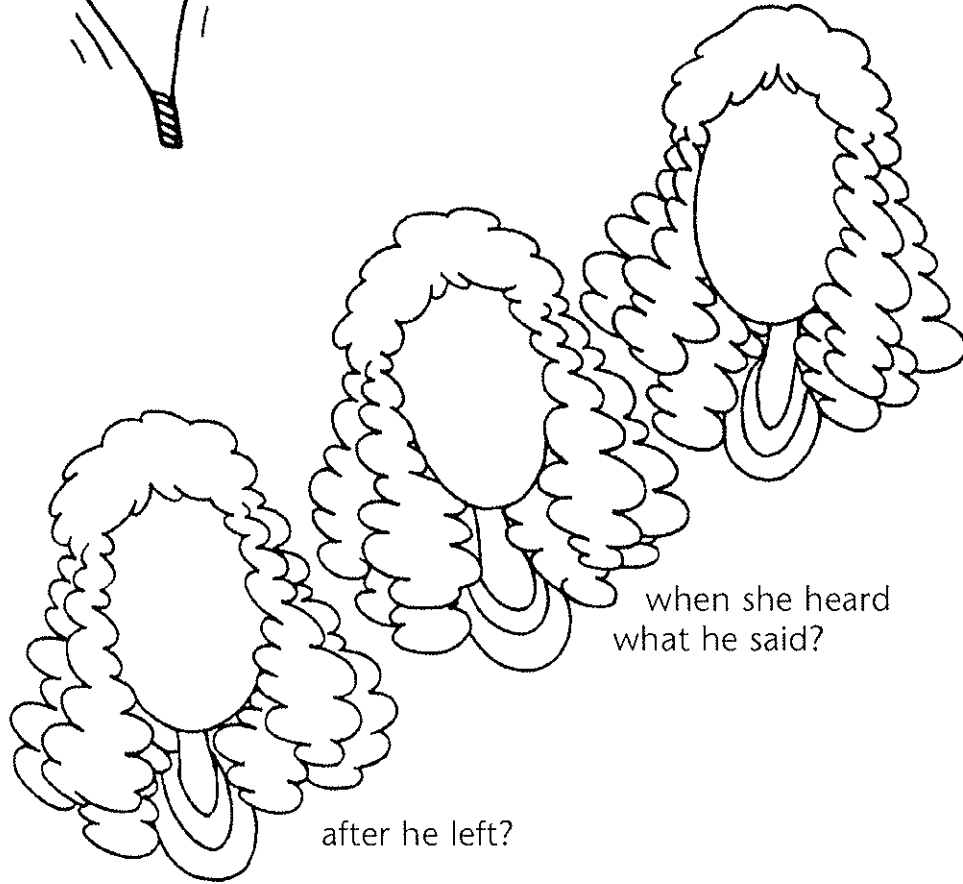

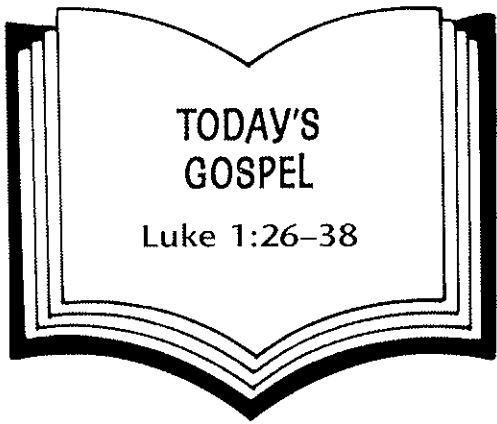

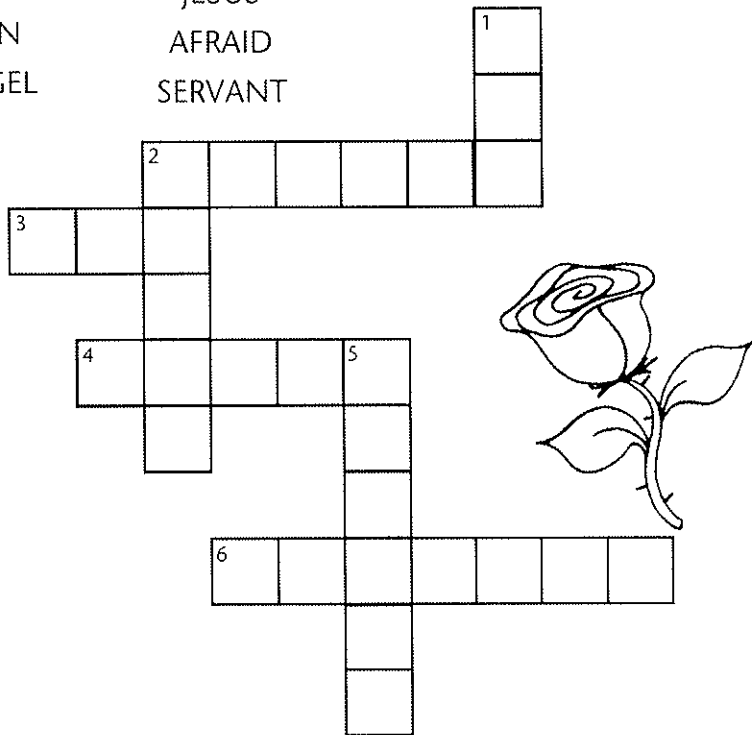


CROSSWORD PUZZLE

In today's Gospel, Mary has a special visitor. Put the words from the story into the crossword puzzle. (If you need help, use the word list.)

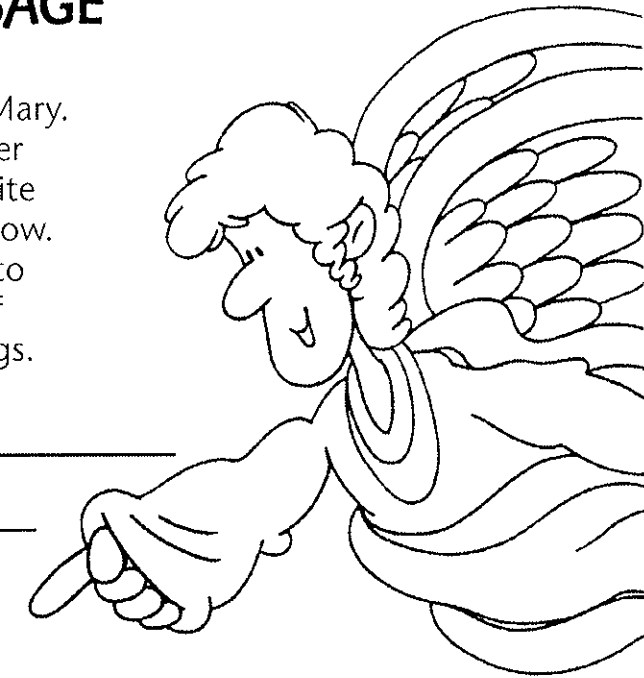
